2.0-Review Previous Minutes

Compared MAP data

3.0- Student Data Update

Review of MAP data (Fall to Winter)

Number of students at the 40th percentile: Math -stayed the same, Reading -went down 3%

By grade level in reading : Kinder: 37-46% 1st went down 3% , 2nd 17 up to 21% , 3rd 23 to 29% , 4th 36 to 36%, 5th 39 to 33%,

Things to consider: the test gets harder, but we were able to keep students moving in relation to the test, but struggling to close the gap as much as we should.

-On staff development day will be diving deeper into the data with staff and focus on grouping

-We discovered that we had a big influx of new students and normally these students come in at lower

academic ability bc they have not spent time with us just yet.

Math : As a school, it remained the same from fall to winter, Kinder stayed the same. 1st stayed the same, 2nd got a percent better, 3rd, 4th almost went up 9%, 5th went down. The essence of the data represents that we have flatlined

Now looking at those students who moved from 40th percentile and higher: Kinder. 25-26%, 1st 16-15%, 2nd 11-13%, 3rd 19-25%, 4th 26-28%, 5th 31-29% and in math: kinder. Moved 4 kids out of lower percentile, 1st moved 2 kids up, 2nd moved 2 kids up, 3rd 2 moved up, 4th 5 moved up, 5th students stayed the same

-On staff development day, will look at specific students falling into these different categories

-Levesque stated that a lot of students grew significantly and is most growth seen in a long time (overall, students are making great growth)
